DIRECTOR'S REPORT
February 11, 2015

- *We have a problem with dental coverage for full-time employees. There isn't any. The Union has not, so far, honored its contractual agreement with the library to provide such insurance, which was to have started February 1st. As of Tuesday, February 9, 2015, I was told by a union representative that the coverage would be made retroactive on Feb. 1st, 2015.*
- *It seems that a family of raccoons residing behind the library building is actually going into our lidded garbage cans and littering the area. We are addressing the issue.*
- *Things seem to be moving steadily towards the library's extension on our second floor. We remove the switches, on Friday, Feb 6, for the 30 computers, which are expected to be operational in a couple of weeks.*
- *Old files from the office have been stored downstairs. And we're reorganizing the work area.*
- *On February 10, McKeon Electric installed electrical outlets and electrical closets.*
- *Furniture for the 2nd floor, both general and computer oriented, computer work area up and down stairs.*
- *I sent the queries to the three libraries (West Hempstead, Rockville Centre and Lynbrook) involving their computer area, I was informed it was set up by their IT person and staff.*
- *The Lakeview Verbal History Project that we are undertaking should have its letter go out to the community this week. I think a key question for participation from residents is: Have you lived in the community 20 or more years? If so, you're the kind of person we would like to interview for our project. Please call at Lakeview Public Library to set up a half-hour appointment.*
